Facilities, details and instructions about the stay during RAM TP 2018

1. The campus of Ram Ratna Vidyamandir has a good infrastructure in terms of hostels, classrooms, security and canteen. Please visit <http://www.ramratnavidyamandir.org/> for details about the school.
2. The participants will not be allowed to go outside the campus for whatsoever reason. All necessary facilities will be provided within the campus.
3. Boys and girls will be put up in different hostels. The dormitories are spacious and comfortable.
4. Vegetarian food will be served during the camp.
5. First aid and medical facilities are available inside the campus.
6. There will be sufficient number of male and female volunteers to take care of the children during the camp.
7. You can give a normal cell phone (**no smart phones allowed**) to the student so that you can talk to them once a day. Throughout the day they will be engaged in activities and classes because of which they will not be able to use the phones often. **Use of cell phones will be allowed only inside the dormitories.** Use of cell phones outside the dormitories is not allowed by the school authorities. Cell phones will be confiscated if anyone is found violating the rules of use of cell phones.
8. As a parent, you are welcome to attend the inaugural function on 20th May at 9:30 am and valedictory function on 26th May at 9:30 am. The program will conclude by lunch time. Return tickets for outstation candidates can be booked accordingly.
9. Due to several constraints, parents cannot be accommodated along with the child during the camp. Hence we suggest that the accompanying person makes their own arrangements for accommodation.
10. The teacher/parent will not be allowed to come and visit the child during the camp.
11. The camp will be residential for all students even if they might be staying close to the venue.
12. If the child is on any regular medication and hence requires parental presence, we request you to intimate us in your email with the details.
13. If the child requires parental presence for any other reason, we request you to kindly pull out the child from the program and give the chance to some other deserving candidate.
14. Use electronic gadgets like iPad, laptop, tablet, MP3 player, etc. by the student during the stay is not allowed. Hence kindly do not send such things with the child.
15. The sessions will begin around 7 am and will continue throughout the day till late evening with adequate breaks in between.
16. Children will have to take care of their own laundry.
17. If any participant is found to be engaged in any indisciplinary activities, the parent will be called immediately and asked to take the child back home.
18. If you are coming from outside Mumbai and if you require accommodation on 19th May, please let us know before 25th January. Dormitory accommodation can be arranged (only for outstation participants' parents) at extra cost for 19th May if you let us know by 25th January.



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19. If the child is homesick and cannot stay without parents for the course, we urge you to let us know by 25th January so that the opportunity can be given to some other deserving candidate.
20. During the training program if the child wishes to go home without continuing the program for whatsoever reason or if we find him/her inappropriate for the program on account of indiscipline, parents will be asked to take the child back by making a donation of Rs. 5,000 to Raising a Mathematician Foundation.
21. Reporting time for the program (for Mumbai participants and those arriving on 20th May) is 7:30 am on 20th May 2018. Please reach the campus on time so that the registration process, room allotment, etc can happen smoothly.
